Special, called meeting to consider White Paper, "TXDOT Will Rebuild I-35. How Can Austin Benefit?":

- Girard requested language that depressed areas have clearance for rail.
- Fully funding bicycle paths will cost \$151M.
- Fully funding high priority sidewalks will cost \$100-200M.
- The white paper was created by about 10 people (including Brendan & Mateo) trying to push their organizations to work together.
- Why should we rush: the "ask" is similar to our previous resolution and we don't have much time if we want a seat at the table.
- Lin noted the white paper is a modest step from our previous resolution.
- At our last meeting, consideration of the white paper was moved by Lin (seconded by Girard). At that meeting, after some discussion, Marty (second by Girard) moved we table the motion and schedule the meeting today (passed unanimously). Today, Marty moved (second by Mateo) to un-table the motion to consider the white paper (passed unanimously).
- The white paper was approved (with friendly amendments, 6-0-1) and our officers are directed to engage with the coalition on behalf of NCINC2.
- Jim moved adjournment (seconded by Girard).
